## **GIRLS— MAJOR CHANGE THIS YEAR— Girls will be grouped by GRADE rather than age.**

**Division A— (Pre-K to 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade)** —35-40-45-50-55-60-HWT

**Division B— (3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> Grade)** —58-65-73-82-91-100-HWT

**Division C— (6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Grade)** —73-82-91-100-115-130-HWT

**An AAU card is required for all participants and WILL BE CHECKED.** AAU cards must be purchased prior to the tournament at [aasports.org](http://aasports.org).

**Also, BOYS BRING BIRTH CERTIFICATE.** (Birth Certificate will not be checked, unless age is challenged by any coach, prior to the start of wrestling.)

**GIRLS BRING REPORT CARD.** (INSTEAD OF BIRTH CERTIFICATE) —for proof of school-grade level, if challenged.

**CONCESSIONS** will be available. Hot Breakfast will be served on site—\$6.00

**NO coolers or glass containers** will be allowed in the gym.

**District t-shirts** will be available to purchase.

**COACHES:** Must have AAU card, which needs to be purchased ahead of time. Coaches Entry Fee is \$15.00. Your AAU card will need to be stamped with SDWCA stamp which will be done the day of districts. The fee for the stamp is \$10.00, **so the total fee for the coaches will be \$25.00**, which will get you: entry to the tournament, SDWCA stamp, and a coaching wrist-band. *You will not be charged for this stamp again, if you coach at regions - only the \$15 entry fee.* Medical assistance will be available for injuries. There will be ZERO tolerance for coaching behavior. Any abuse to any tournament official, participant, referee, or volunteer will result in your immediate removal. All disputes are to be taken to the head referee in a civil manner.

In case of **inclement weather**, announcements will be made on KMIT 105.9 - Mitchell and KPLO 94.5 - Reliance.
