Divisions: All participants must have a birth certificate and AAU Card

Must wrestle in the same age group and weight class as qualified at districts - no weight allowance. Singlets are required at weigh in.

Girls Division must have an AAU card, Report Card and Birth Certificate

- Grades 6th-8th
- Grades 9th-12th

Boys Division must have an AAU card and Birth Certificate

- Tots (6 & U)
- Bantam (7&8)
- Midgets (9 & 10)
- Novice (11&12)
- Schoolboy (13 & 14)

Cadets (15 & 16) Boys (**Freestyle**) must have a USA card, and Girls (**Folkstyle**) Division must have an AAU card both must have a Birth Certificate.
